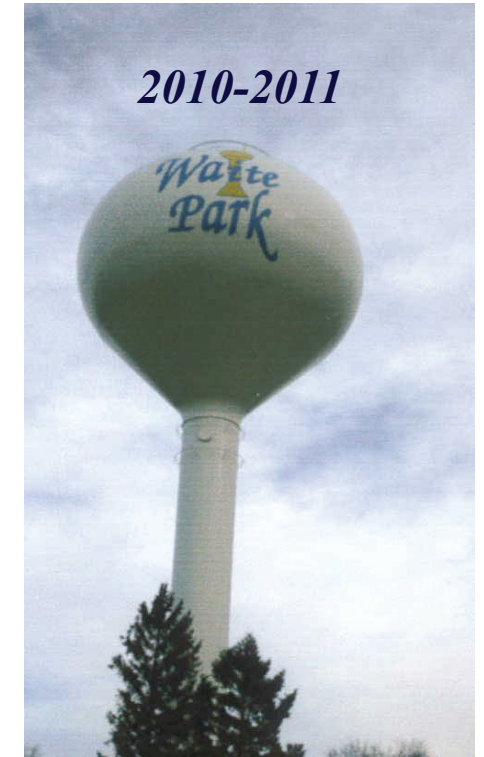

Waite Park Chamber Mission

The Waite Park Chamber, a division of the St. Cloud Area Chamber of Commerce, provides a place where business, education, and government can come together for the betterment of the Waite Park community.

The Waite Park Chamber

Since its creation in March 2004, the Waite Park Chamber continues to grow thanks to the dedicated volunteers and businesses that take part.

Monthly Meetings

Meetings of the Waite Park Chamber are held on the third Wednesday of each month. The meetings are sponsored by local businesses and are hosted at the sponsoring business' facility or another location such as the Waite Park City Hall. All St. Cloud Area Chamber members and their guests are invited to attend the monthly meetings. An email notice is sent out one week prior to the meeting to those who have asked to be on the reminder list.

What To Expect

Usually 70-90 people attend a Waite Park Chamber meeting. Everyone who attends has the opportunity to do an introduction at the beginning of the meeting. Then we take two minutes so you can meet someone new or connect with a business associate.

Once everyone is settled back into their chairs, we hear a 10-15 minute presentation from our host. This is usually information about their product or service presented in an interesting and educational manner.

Following the host we have a second speaker. This speaker is educational and topics vary widely from Waite Park economic development to easy tips for saving money to services provided to the community through local non-profit agencies.

To meet our mission of bringing business, education and government together, each meeting includes brief updates from the City of Waite Park, School District 742, and the Chamber of Commerce. There is also time at the end of each meeting for announcements and testimonials from those in attendance.

Registration

Because our meetings are sponsored by a local business, there is no cost to attend. However, we do require advance registration so we can ensure that there is plenty of seating and food available for everyone. For those who do not register in advance there is a \$5 charge at the door.
