Why Volunteer?

The success of the St. Cloud Area Chamber and its work in the community depend on a strong, active volunteer force. As a member of the Chamber you and others on your staff are welcome to actively participate in the meetings and projects of our volunteer committees.

The Chamber's volunteer program strives to create an environment that is friendly and welcoming. As a Chamber volunteer, you work closely with the Chamber staff who are an active part of each committee. They are there to assist you and to answer questions about how the Chamber operates and to help you be the most effective volunteer possible.

Matching

After completing and returning the volunteer application, a member of the Chamber staff will call and talk with you about your interest areas and time commitment. They will help you find the best fit. Once you choose a committee you will be added to the committee roster and begin receiving meeting notices.

Length

Most volunteer commitments are ongoing and leadership positions are held for 1-2 years. Most committees meet monthly for 1-1.5 hours. In addition, committees often require tasks to be completed outside of the meetings on the volunteer's own time.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

B.I.G. (Big Idea Group)

The Chamber's B.I.G. committee supports and enhances Chamber activities by promoting increased engagement through fresh and relevant event and program ideas. Volunteers will first serve on a B.I.G. focus group, then can choose to also help coordinate any subsequent events.

Business Development Council (BDC)

The BDC Provides education and training opportunities to Chamber members in order to assist in their success and growth. Volunteers that like to keep busy planning, promoting, coordinating, and educating are just right for this committee. Programs include: Lunchtime Learning, the Supervisor Development Certificate Program, and additional classes as relevant.

Central Minnesota Farm Show Committee

The Central Minnesota Farm Show, the largest indoor farm show in the Upper Midwest, runs for two days at the River's Edge Convention Center and boasts over 350 booths and over 200 exhibitors. Volunteers secure exhibitors, plan publicity, make booth assignments and help with set up and tear down and registration both days of the show. If you want to be a part of the Chamber's largest fundraiser and you like all the details of event planning, you will fit right in. The committee meets monthly May—February.

NEXT—Chamber's Emerging Leaders

Participants of the NEXT— Chamber's Emerging Leaders program are encouraged to be an integral part of planning this next-generation professional development program. Volunteers can participate in organizing speakers, events and promotions. NEXT meetings are the second Tuesday of the month over lunch. The planning committee meets quarterly for about 1.5 hours.

Chamber Connection Location Committee

Chamber Connection is a high-energy networking group that gives Chamber members an opportunity to exchange business information, ideas, products and services. Location Committee volunteers meet monthly and are responsible for planning and scheduling Chamber Connection meetings, including but not limited to securing sponsors and locations. Applications are accepted year-round.

Chamber Open Committee

The Chamber's annual golf outing features a shotgun start, prizes, food, and great networking. Volunteers solicit sponsors, collect door prizes, and help the day of the Open which is always the second Monday in August. The committee meets monthly January—August.

Diversity Council

The purpose of the Diversity Council of the St. Cloud Area Chamber of Commerce is to support an inclusive business community by encouraging all Chamber members to advocate, enhance and promote equity of opportunity in all of their business practices.

Government Affairs Committee

Volunteers serve as a link between local and state governments and the business community. Members carry the Chamber's policy positions to the legislature. Projects include candidate and legislative forums and planning monthly meetings and annual events. Government Affairs meetings are the third Wednesday of the month from 8-9 a.m.

Marketing Committee

Volunteers with a background in marketing, sales or promotion assist the Chamber staff in creating new membership programs and reviewing and promoting current activities.

St. Cloud Area Leadership Program Committee

Graduates of the St. Cloud Area Leadership Program are encouraged to be an integral part of planning this nine- month community leadership program. Volunteers can participate in interviewing and selecting candidates or day planning and coordinating.

Star Celebration Committee

The Chamber's annual volunteer recognition event honors those volunteers who served as chair of a committee during the year. Volunteers assist with planning, promotion, decorations, sponsorships and event registrations. The committee meets monthly February—October.

Sauk Rapids Chamber

Volunteers work to promote Sauk Rapids through projects and special events. This may be of particular interest to those who live or work in Sauk Rapids. The Sauk Rapids Chamber meets the fourth Thursday of the month at 11:45 a.m. Location varies.

Waite Park Chamber
